

## **Tim Goossens**

**Tim Goossens** is a curatorial advisor of the Clocktower Gallery in New York, which is one of the premier exhibition venues for sound art, and the curatorial director of Envoy Enterprises. Born and raised in Belgium, he moved to Paris to pursue a Masters in Art History at Paris IV- Sorbonne, and a Masters Cum Laude in Museology at the prestigious Ecole du Louvre. Goossens moved to New York in 2006 and was an Assistant Curator at MoMA PS1 until 2010. At PS1, he curated the group exhibition *Between Spaces* (2009), and collaborated on major exhibitions including *Kenneth Anger* (2009) and *Greater New York* (2010) and co-curated the acclaimed performance series *Saturday Sessions*. As an independent curator, Goossens sits on the advisory committee of SoHO House New York and is a Curatorial Director at envoy enterprises in New York. He organized an exhibition for the Berlin Biennial (2012), and has organized solo exhibitions at the Dactyl Foundation, New York 2009, Ellen Depoorter (Governor's Island, New York, 2009), Daria Marchik (Kiev, Ukraine, 2009), and curated the major Belgian group show *Avec le Temps - In Temps* (Robert Miller Gallery, New York, 2009) and *RISD Expose* (RISD, Providence, 2010).
